# IWMA moves east: 14<sup>th</sup> IWMC takes place in Istanbul

Never before has the IWMA been as far east as this with its annual conference! The venue was still in Europe, but from the windows of the meeting room Asia was highly visible.

In all, 94 participants from 20 countries attended this year's International Water Mist Conference. They had travelled from as far as China, Australia, South Africa and the United States. The largest delegation was the Turkish one with 16 delegates followed by the Danish group with 12 delegates.

During the two-day conference 19 speakers gave 18 presentations. Some delegates attended day one of the conference only which was "Applications Day". This conference day was rounded off with a panel discussion on the future of water mist. Afterwards the IWMA invited all delegates to an evening reception. Day two of the conference was dedicated to research and testing.
